Eligibility requirements:

- Age 19-30
- Must be bondable
- Not attending school
- Out of work
- No EI attachment
- Little or no skill based training/ certificates
- Drivers License is an asset

Participants will:

- Participate in four weeks of **paid in-class training** (beginning in February 8, 2010). Participants will be paid for 6 hours per day / 5 days a week at \$8 per hour.
- Receive a work clothing allowance
- Obtain: **BST Level 1 & 2, First Aid, Traffic Control Person Certificate, WHMIS & more**
- Have the opportunity for a paid 2 week / 60 hour work-experience placement.

- Connect with job ready and motivated youth
